We take the pleasure to invite you for the **summer school** organised in cooperation with partner universities within the frame of the Erasmus+ programme:

GREEN SOLUTIONS FOR BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY

29 August - 12 September 2015

ŠKODA AUTO University Mladá Boleslav, Czech Republic

Working language of the programme is English.







The programme will focused in particular on green logistics and sustainable solutions in businesses. It includes solving case studies from practice, active workshops led by experts from practice, and excursion to companies connected with the automotive industry. The students will receive 3 ECTS after successful completion of the programme.

The programme includes:

- Subjects related to logistics.
- International team of lecturers and guest speakers.
- Excursions and field trips.
- Social and cultural programme, sport and entertainment.





Costs for participants:

Based on the Erasmus grant, the tuition, seminars, centrally organized excursions and field trips, as well as organised culture, sport and entertainment programme are free of charge.

The participants from our partner universities in Dresden, Seinäjoki, Steyr, Wroclaw and Žilina will receive the scholarship for their travel and subsistence cost for the programme.

The lump sum for the subsistence costs is 810 Euro per the whole stay. The travel costs will be also covered in the amount of 275 Euro. To be eligible to receive the grant, the student has to participate in all the academic programme and organized activities.

Accommodation is arranged by ŠKODA AUTO University at the hostel Na Karmeli (50 meters from the university); the price is approximately 200 Euro for the stay. Meals and other costs will be easily covered by the rest of the Erasmus+ grant.

It is a great chance to stay at partner university for shorter time, work in international teams, learn about the Czech Republic, the towns of Mladá Boleslav, Prague and their surroundings, meet new people and cultures, exchange ideas, find out about the study programmes at other EU universities, earn ECTS, have fun, gain new experience and discover new opportunities.

The programme is open for bachelor and master degree students.


